CoP/KM Technical Requirements (wish list)

- Membership structure that enables
 - Users to join & leave without administrator assistance
 - Invite others to the group with automatic linkage to email for the invitation
 - Viewable membership list for the group
 - That also includes an online presence indicator
- Access restrictions
 - Public everyone can see all the content and can join without restriction
 - Closed membership by invitation only. Existence of the group is public, but all content is hidden from non-members
 - Hidden double private to everyone but those specifically invited to join
- Member profile that is shared across all groups
 - Lists recent contributions across all groups & MSE ratings
- Group home page that is easily configured
 - User initiated formation of new groups without administrator intervention
 - Lists recent contributions and discussion postings & SMEs for the group
 - Built on a style template that can be reflected across multiple pages
- Identifies subject matter experts based upon their activity in the group (document & discussion postings) and content ratings by others
- Email notifications that are <u>automatically</u> set up when joining the group.
 - These defaults can be modified by the user later by email or web interface
 - Configurable frequency & scope of what is notified
- Hierarchical organization of groups that permit sub-topic groupings to easily form
- Robust search function across multiple platforms
- Workflow that ideally integrates with Outlook tasks
- Role-based permissions
- Templates that can be used for easily duplicating features & folder structures for new groups
- Wizards that provide assistance in performing infrequently used functions
- Automatic check-out/check-in of documents being edited
- Group editing of documents
- Easy reorganization of folders to reflect organizational changes
- Easily configured reporting of activity with little programming knowledge
- Threaded discussions that accept both web and email postings
- Integrated group calendar built from the Outlook calendar for each group member
- Controllable "unread" function
